### **ABSTRACT**

The Lost Creek In-Situ Uranium Project is Ur-Energy’s primary production center and has yielded more than two million pounds U<sub>3</sub>O<sub>8</sub> since commencement of operations. Development of the project started in 2006 and production began in August, 2013. This presentation will review the challenges and successes of the project as well as future development and operating opportunities.
